Akira Matsumori received his M.D. degree from Kyoto University School of Medicine and a Ph.D. degree from the Graduate School Kyoto University, Japan. Dr. Matsumori is the founder and current president of the International Society of Cardiomyopathies, Myocarditis and Heart Failure as well as serves as a Visiting Director at the Clinical Research Center of the Kyoto Medical Center. He has served as Secretary of the World Heart Federation, President of the Asian Pacific Society of Cardiology, and has also been an Instructor and Visiting Professor at the Harvard Medical School. Dr. Matsumori's research interest includes pathogenesis of heart disease, biomarkers and therapy of heart failure, cardiomyopathies and myocarditis, and the roles of cytokines, immunity and inflammation in cardiovascular diseases.
