Dr. Fujita received his medical degree from Kyoto University. He obtained his PhD in the Department of Cardiovascular Medicine with the late Dr. Chuichi Kawai. His clinical interests include coronary artery disease, coronary collateral circulation, etc. He started research career at Dalton Research Center, University of Missouri, Columbia, USA under the supervision of the late Dean Franklin.

Dr. Fujita has developed heparin exercise treatment for myocardial ischemia by potentiating pre-existent coronary collateral circulation.

At present, Dr. Fujita contribute to the establishment of regional medical structure in Uji city, Kyoto.

Dr. Fujita has published more than 350 English manuscripts, covering the various fields of cardiovascular medicine.

Dr. Fujita has received several awards, including Japanese Circulation Society (JCS) Young Investigator Award, Japanese Society of Internal Medicine Encouragement Award and Super Reviewers Award of the Cardiovascular Research (2009).
